# Visa Application Process & Checklist

## Canadian Visa Application Process:

1. Apply to our School and Receive an Official Offer from the School.

# Credit Transfers & Grade Placement

**Ontario High School** diplomas require **30 credits/courses** for graduation. This include **18 compulsory credits** and **12 elective credits**. For international students, if they have completed part of their high school education in their home country and then transfer to an Ontario high school, the number of transferable credits is as follows :

- **Graduated from Grade 8 in the home country:** Directly enroll in Grade 9, no transferable credits;
- **Complete Grade 9 in the home country:** Directly enroll in Grade 10, up to 8 transferable credits;
- **Complete Grade 10 in the home country:** Directly enroll in Grade 11, up to 16 transferable credits;
